



**Terms and Conditions**  
**'Kids Alive Do The Five' Jingle Promotion**

**16 August 2010 to 13 September 2010**

1. Instructions on how to enter form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The promotion is open to all Primary School students of South East Queensland. Employees and immediate families of Protector Aluminium, and 'Kids Alive Do The Five' and their associated parties are not eligible to enter.
3. The promotion commences Monday August 16, 2010 at 09:00am and ceases Friday September 13, 2010 at 12:00pm (noon) (Competition Period). There will be five (5) finalists and one (1) winner for the promotion.
4. The winner of this promotion will be filmed to appear in a national television community service announcement shown in metropolitan and regional Australia, along with a radio community service announcement to be recorded from the filming and distributed in metropolitan and regional Australia.
5. Filming of the winner will take place in September with the date/time at discretion of the promoters. Students will need to be available for filming for a two (2) hour period with an hour and half to set up before hand. School uniforms are to be worn. Laurie Lawrence will appear in the filming along with the students.
6. To enter the promotion, Primary School's must register their details with The Buzz PR through the registration form provided with letter of promotion posted to schools or available through the Protector Aluminium ([www.protectoraluminium.com.au](http://www.protectoraluminium.com.au)) or 'Kids Alive Do the Five' ([www.kidsalive.com.au](http://www.kidsalive.com.au)) websites. The registration form will ask Primary Schools for the following information: name of school, address and contact details, name of teacher submitting registration, number of students involved, class type i.e. Year 5 or School Choir. Information provided may be used to form a part of Protector Aluminium, 'Kids Alive Do The Five' and associated parties database, if you wish to not have your details placed on any database there will be an box available to tick on the registration form. All entrants must be Primary School students at time of entering.

13. The winner consents to the use of the Primary School's name, and area and image for promotional and marketing purposes and agrees to participate in reasonable promotional activities as requested by the promoter.
14. 'Kids Alive Do The Five' and Protector Aluminium and its employees and agents will be fully released from and indemnified by the winner in respect of any claim for any accident, injury, property damage or loss of life in connection with winner's participation in the prize.
