



LIFESAVER LIL'S TIPS ON POOL SAFETY

- Tip 1: Lifesaver Lil suggests that kids always need to have adult supervision when they go swimming.
- Tip 2: Lifesaver Lil believes that a fence should completely enclose the pool or spa area.
- Tip 3: Lifesaver Lil thinks that adults need to check the gates or doors leading to the pool area are self-closing and have self-latching mechanisms. This should help stop kids entering the pool area unattended.
- Tip 4: Lifesaver Lil says adults need to be sure that a latch on the pool gate is out of reach of young kids.
- Tip 5: Lifesaver Lil believes that adults should learn how to resuscitate.
- Tip 6: Lifesaver Lil recommends removing objects near the pool fence that may allow a kid to climb over into the pool area.
- Tip 7: Lifesaver Lil thinks that adults need to be wary of pool covers as they can tempt kids to crawl or walk on them
- Tip 8: Lifesaver Lil wants kids to stay away from the pool if unattended.
- Tip 9: Lifesaver Lil advises adults to teach kids how to swim at an early age under adult supervision.
- Tip 10: Lifesaver Lil warns adults not to permit kids to scream, even playfully, at the pool as it can potentially mask a real cry for help.
